of Philadelphia. These are to will & require thee forthw<sup>th</sup>  
to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto him a Lott on Skull-  
hill in any of ye Streets sett out for Purchasers of ye like  
Quantity and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office.  
Given at Philadelphia ye 19<sup>th</sup> of ye 12<sup>th</sup> M<sup>o</sup> 1683.
