

The 10<sup>th</sup> day of ye 4<sup>th</sup> mo. 1688.

Surveyed and layed out to William Bradford a tract of Land in the County of Philadelphia and in the Township of Pemaapecka begining at a black oak tree marked for a Corner. being the North West bounds of Richard Coates Land thence North East by the said Coates Land four hundred and Eighty perches. thence North west by Susquahanah roade one hundred perches to a post. thence by the Land of Nicholas Scull, <sup>s.w.</sup> four hundred and Eighty perches to a post for another Corner. thence South East by the Land of Jasper Farmer one hundred perches to the first mentioned Corner tree. Surveyed for three hundred acres of Land.
