By Vertue of a War^t from ye Com^rs Bearing date ye 18th of ye 2^d mo^e. 1687 Directed to me I here by Certifie into ye Secretarys office. that I have Caused to be Surveyed and Laid out ye 26th of ye 2^d mo^e. 1687 unto Nath. Brumly. Purchas^r of two Thousand acres. his Lotts in ye City of Philadelphia proportionable and belonging to him by his Said Purchase. his Front Lott Containeth in Breadth forty foot and in Length on ye North Side here of from ye front (bl.) street to ye Swamp — foot and from ye west side of ye Said Swamp to the Second Street — foot and on ye South Side of ye Said Lott from ye Second Street to ye Swamp — foot and from ye East Side of ye Said Swamp to the Front Street — foot. Bounded Northward with Jn^o Wheelers Lott. to ye West ward with ye Second Street. to ye South ward with Jn^o Roynolds Lott. and to ye East ward with ye Front Street at Delaw^r. The Lott in ye High Street Containth in Breadth fifty two foot and a halfe and in Length three hundred and Six foot. Bounded East ward with ye ~~Second~~ Seventh Street from Delaw^r. South ward with Back Lotts West ward with Jn^o Roynolds Lott & to ye North ward with ye High Street. And is accordingly Entred and Recorded in my Office at Philadelp. ye 28th of ye second Month 1687.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this tenth day of June 1909.
