This may Certifie into the Gener^l Survey^r's office that I have Carefully Resurvey'd and Lay'd out to the aforesaid Paul Barns his said Lott containing a Long the green or market place 72 feet to the S: E. to the S: W: 169 feet Bounded w^t Major John Tomsons Lott. on the N: W: 72 feet a Long Bever Street on the N: E: 169 feet Bounded with Rob^t Bryen Lott.
