At the request of John Rudolph Bundeli, Purchaser of five hundred acres of Land in this province, that we would Grant him to tak-up the same pursuant to a minute of our Agreem^t with him on ye tenth day of this Instant. These are therefore to Authorize & Require thee to Survey or cause to be Surveyd unto the Said John Rudolph Bundeli adjoining the ten thousand acres located or to be laid out for the Swissers or some where thereabouts that has not been already Surveyd nor taken up nor Seated by the Indians. to be held by the sd John Rudolph Bundeli, his heirs & Assignes under the yearly quit rent of ^{for each hundred acres} one Shilling Sterling money of Great Britain, to be paid to the Prop^{ry} his heirs & Assignes & Subject to distress in case of nonpayment. And make returns thereof into the Secretaries Office.
Given under our hands & Seal of the province at Philadelphia the Eleventh day of the Eighth month in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and ten.
