By the Commissioners of Property.

Upon an Agreement made between us and Abraham Beaks, John Musgrove & Moses Musgrove. These are to require thee forthwith to Survey and lay out to the said Abraham, John and Moses all that vacant Tract of Land lying in the County of Chester between Edgemont and Willis town, the Lands of Thomas Brassey and Thomas Rous, according to the out Lines of the Lands bounding the Same. Also to Survey and lay out in such place of the said Tract as Caleb Pusey, Nicholas Pyle and Nathan Newland shall direct so much of the said Tract as by them shall be thought sufficient to accommodate the Indians lately settled there. And make Returns there of into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be deliv'd thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 11<sup>th</sup> day of the 12<sup>th</sup> Mo<sup>th</sup> 1701.
