are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Surveyed
unto the said William Bucher in ye place aforesaid the said one
hundred Acres of Land provided the Same be clear from all
former Surveys & Lawfull Claimes and make returns there of
into the Secretarys Office which Survey in case the said
William Bucher fulfill the above agreement within three months
after the date here of shall be Valid otherwise the Same is to be
Void as if- had never been made nor this Warrant ever granted.
Given under our hands & the lesser Seal of the Province at
Philadelphia ye 5th day of the Third Month Anno Din. 1720.*
