Purchase of Land in ye County of Philadelphia. These are to will & require  
Thee forthw<sup>th</sup> to survey for him a Lott in ye Street allotted to ye Purc-  
hasers of five hundred Acres in a place not already taken up &  
make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office.

Given at Philadelphia ye 26<sup>th</sup> of ye 12 mo. 1682.
