Lieing west of Concord Called Brumesum. begining at a marked hickry tree being the Corner mark of ~~John Jones~~ John Jones Land and runing W.S.W. 400 pertch to a marked hickry, then S.S.E. 14 pertch to a marked red oak, then W.S.W. 90 pertch to a marked red oak, then S.S.E. 80 pertch to a marked maple standing by a run, then up the run on severall courses to a marked walnut tree, from thence runing S.S.E. 56 pertch to a marked red oak being a marked Corner tree of John Brendsons land, thence runing along the sd<sup>d</sup> Brunsdons line E.N.E. 400 pertch to a marked hickry and from thence runing N.N.W. 160 pertch to the first menched hickry.
