

This may Certifie that on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of October 1718 there was survey'd and Land Laid out to Thomas Baldwin a certain Piece of Land on Conestogo Creek in the County of Chester. (being part of a Tract Laid out to James Hendricks on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of October 1716 by a Warrant from the Commissioners dated the fifth of the Eleventh Month 1714.) Beginning at a White Oak Marked at a Corner of Thomas Gales land and on the south Side of the said Conestogo Creek. Thence South by East by the said Gales Land fifty Eight pch<sup>s</sup> to a <sup>D-78 19</sup> Hickery tree. Then South sixteen degrees East by John Linvels land two hundred and twenty pches to a post. Then West <sup>west</sup> South One hundred twenty ~~eight~~ eight pches to a post. Then North by the land of the said James Hendricks three hundred and ten pches to a White Oak by the said Creek. Then up the several Courses of the same one hundred and fifteen pches to the Place of Beginning Containing two hundred Acres with the usual allowance.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this fourteenth day of May 1909.
