I have surv<sup>d</sup> and layd out unto John Budd, Brewer a tract of Land in ye County of Chester. begining at a Corner Black oak. being a Corner tree standing in a line of Leticia penns Mannor. thenc- South 443 1/2 p. to a Corner Black oak being a Corner of Judq-Guests Land and thenc- Est. 324 p. to a hickery. then north 123 1/2 pch. to a post. then west 199 pch. to a Corner w<sup>t</sup> oak being a Corner of Rawlings<sup>sc</sup> Land then North 320 pch. to a Black oak then west 125 pch to ye place of beqing. Containing 500 Acres. the 25. 10<sup>br</sup> 1703.
