These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Surveyed unto the Said Michael Poughman at or near the Place aforesaid according to the Method of Townships appointed. the Said quantity of four Hundred Acres of Land that hath ^{not} been already Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seated by the Indians and make Returns there of into the Secretarys Office. w^{ch} Survey in case the Said Michael fulfill the above agreement within three Months after the date here of shall be Valid otherwise the same is to be Void as if it had never been made nor this Warrant ever granted.
