to me directed bearing date the 15th day of the 6th month 1700.

I do hereby certify that I have caused to be surveyed unto Ann and Sarah
Bennett in right of their Father William Bennett purchaser of one thousand
acres a certain Tract of Land situate on the south side of Brandywine Creek
in the County of Chester. beginning at a marked Hickery being a corner tree of
Joseph Pike's Land taken up by his Attorney Thomas Story. from thence by a
line of marked trees dividing that said Tract from this four hundred perches
to another marked Hickery. from thence West one hundred and sixty perches
to a corner post. from thence South four hundred perches to another corner post.
from thence East one hundred and sixty perches to the first mentioned
hickery. Containing and laid out for four hundred Acres. Surveyed the 26th
day of the 10th month 1700. and Returned according to the above said Survey
and Bounds. into the Proprietarys and Governours Secretary's Office.
the 16th day of the 2^d month 1701.
