rses to a ~~mark~~ post standing by ye riverside and from thence down by the
riverside to first mencheden post. The other parcell of land lieng on the s
west side of marcus creek begining at a markt white oak stump and from
thence runing N78 degrees east 102 perch to a markt red oak ~~standing~~ by ye
creek side and runing up the creek on severall coarses ~~to~~ ~~a~~ ~~mark~~ red oak
from thence ~~SSE 180~~ perch thence ~~578~~ degrees w to a marked post and from
thence S. S. E. 50 perch to the first mencheden stump.
