

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing date 23^d of the 12th month 1702. for laying out unto John Budd six hundred and twenty acres of land. the remainder untaken up of Nathaniel Allen his Original purchase of Two ~~thousand~~ thousand acres. Now purchased by the said John of Nehemiah Allen. son to ye said Nathaniel.

There was Survey'd and laid out to the said John Budd the 25th of the first Month 1703. the said quantity of six hundred and twenty five acres of Land in the County of Chester. beginning at a black oak at a Corner of the London Company's land. Then by the line of the said Company's land North three hundred and twelve perches and a half to a black oak. Then West three hund^d₂ twenty perches to a black oak. Then South three hundred and twelve perches and a half to a black oak. Then by the line of the said London Company's land East three hundred and twenty perches to the place of the Beginning.
