Doe hereby declare the Eighty acres omitted in the Tocation of Returne of Humphrey Soutes purchase of 1000 acres is laydout, in their respective Lands of Thomas Barber Samuel Jobson, Sabian Cole, John Mare & Joseph Moore in ye County of Chester. And so prevent any future scruples that may happen to arise concerning ye premises wee and desire ye Survey" Gen'all to Enter & Record this in his Office that there it may appear. how. where & in what maner both of ye sapsons are satisf yed their respective purchased Lands aforesd In witness whereof we have hereunto set or hands this Eight Day of ye first month 1687. being ye third year of ye Kings Raign & Seaventh year of ye proprietary Government.
