These are therefore to will & require thee forthwith in ye Proprietary's Name to Survey or cause to be surveyed unto him yesd quantity of Land in ye aforesaid County where not already taken up according to the Method of Townships appointed by ye Govern'r he seating & improving ye same wthin Six Month from yedate of Survey, and make returns there of into ye Govern'r^{rs} Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia the 16th Dec 10th M^o 1684.
