At ye Request of Mary Baker, that we would grant her to take up fifty acres of Land being her head right in the County of Chester. These are therefore in the Proprietary's Name to will & require thee forthwith to Survey or cause to be Surveyed unto her ye sd number of acres in the aforementioned County where not all ready taken up according to ye Method of Townships appointed by ye Govern'r she seating & Improving the same within Six Moneths from ye date of Survey and make returns thereof into the Govern'r Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia the 25th of ye 9th M^o 1684.
