

By Vertue of two Warrants Each for five hundred acres of Land.
 By the Commisioners directed to us Distinctly to Survey and layout
 unto John Budd of Philadelphia Brewer one Thousand Acres of
 Land bearing date the fourth of the sixth moth Anno: 1702. We doe hereby
 Certifye into the Gen^l. Survey^s Office. That the day here under written
 we did survey and bound out unto the said John Budd one Thousand
 acres of Land within the County of Chester. Begining at a post being
 the upper bounds of the Land of Joshua Carpenter and Comp. Thence by
 Vacant Land South West five hundred perches to a Corner marked
 hickry. Thence by vacant Land South East Three hundred and Twenty
 perches to a post near the head of a small branch. Thence North East
 by Vacant Land and the Land of John Joyce five hundred perches to
 a post for the other Corner. Thence North West by the said Carpenter
 and Comp. Land Three hundred and twenty perches to the first
 mentioned Corner post. yt as aforesaid Laid out the 30th of Sep^r
 1703.
