thee fforthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him the said Number of
Acres, in the afores^d County where not already taken upp; according to the
Method of Townshipp appointed by the Govern^t he seating and Improving
the same, within six months after the Date of Survey; and make Returne
hereof to the Secretarys office Dated at Philadelphia the 11th of 3^d month
1686.
