of Pennsylvania, & ye Territories thereunto belonging

Whereas I understand, yt one Thomas Atkinson hath bought  
of one of my Purchasers five hundred Acres of Land, & taken y<sup>m</sup> up  
together at ye Falls, w<sup>ch</sup> is contrary to my order & Custom: And since John  
Rowland hath requested me, yt I would grant him to take up Three hund-  
red Acres of his Purchase: These are to will & require thee forthw<sup>th</sup> to survey  
or cause to be survey'd unto him ye half of ye sd five hundred Acres fast  
Land and swamp joyning thereto on ye outside fifty Acres more for com-  
pleating his Three hundred Acres, according to the Method of Townships  
appointed by me, and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office.  
Given at Pennberry ye 7<sup>th</sup> 7<sup>th</sup> 1683
