William Penn Proprietary & Govern<sup>or</sup> of ye Province of Pennsylvania, and ye Territories thereunto belonging.

At ye Request of Thomas Revell, yt I would grant him to take up Two hundred & fifty Acres of Land in ye County of Bucks: These are to will and require thee forthw<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to be Survey'd unto him ye said Number of Acres in ye afores<sup>d</sup> County, in a place not already taken up, according to ye Method of Townships appointed by me, and make returns thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 16<sup>th</sup> of ye 3<sup>rd</sup> 1683.
