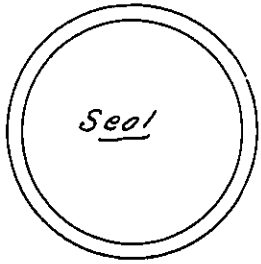


Pensylvania

 to Resurvey the said Tract according to the first Bounds and Original
 Lines of Survey: And make Returns into the General Surveyors Office
 at Philad^{ia} where this Warrt is to remain and a Copy thereof to be deliv^d
 to thee certified by y^e Secretary. Given under our hands and the Seal of
 the Province at Philad^{ia} the 31st of the 3^d moth 1703.
