*Upon ye Request of Thomas Rowland A Purchaser That I would grant him Liberty to take up Two Hundred Acres of land in A Place not already Taken up These are forthwith to Require Thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto ye s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Rowland ye s<sup>d</sup> Two Hundred Acres according to ye Method of Townships already P<sup>r</sup>scribed & to make Returne thereof into my Secretary's office Given at Philadelphia this 17<sup>th</sup> of ye first month 1683.*

*29<sup>th</sup> 8<sup>m</sup> orderd J Taylor to lay it out, not to Delaware, but backward*
