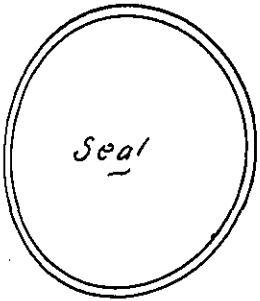

Given under our hands and seals at Philadelphia the 25th of the 12th Month 1701.
