to John Cutler dated the 10th day of the first month 1701 Authorizing him
to execute all warrants directed to the said Pemberton The said Jn.^e
Cutler hath Resurveyed to John Swift a Tract of land in Warminster in
the County of Bucks formerly laid out to William Bingley for 492 acres and
hath made Returns thereof in the General Surveyor's office which being
there Examined and Revised is as follows viz:
The said land beginning at a small ash tree by a Run called Southampton Run at
the Corner of land belonging to the Proprietarie from thence by the said land south west
318 perches to a post by a dead tree from thence north west by Peter Chamberlains
land two hundred ninety two perches to a post by the Corner of the said Chamberlains
fence ~~Corner~~ thence north east by Abel Noble's land 318 perches to a post thence
south east by John Rush his land 292 perches to the place of beginning Con-
