


By virtue of a Warr.^t from the Proprietor bearing date the 25th day of the 8th month 1701, Surveyed & laid out unto the Assigns of William Penington a tract of Land in Plumstead township in the County of Bucks Beginning at a Post by a white oak sixteen perches South West from Francis Plumstead's Corner, from thence extending North West by vacant & Jeremiah Langhorn's Land four hundred thirty two perches to a heap of stones, Then by vacant Land North East one hundred eighty five perches & an half₅ to a white oak, Then South East by vacant Land four hundred thirty two perches to a Post between a small white oak & a Hickory in the 5^d Plumstead's Line, Then by the 5^d Line South West one hundred eighty five perches & an half perch to the place of beginning Containing five hundred acres Surveyed the 10th of the 6th month 1716. This Tract of Land is now in possession of Sarah Stevenson & Joseph Kirkbride
