

I do hereby certify that by virtue of a Warrant under the hands  
of the Commissioners of Propertie and the Seal of the Province to Phineas  
Pemberton directed bearing date the 21<sup>st</sup> day of the 11<sup>th</sup> month 1701 and pur-  
suant to a warrant from the said Commissioners to Jno<sup>o</sup> Cutler authorizing  
him to execute all warrants directed to the said Pemberton. The said John  
Cutler hath made Returns into the General Surveyor's office of the Resurvey of a  
Tract of Land Resurvey'd to Jonas Sheen the 25<sup>th</sup> day of the first month 170 $\frac{1}{2}$   
which being Examined and Revised in the said office is as followeth Viz:  
in Bensalem township  
Situate in the County of Bucks Beginning at a post at Tobias Dimock's Corner by  
Delaware River from thence extending north north west by the said Dimock's land two  
hundred eighty two perches to a post thence northeast by Thomas Hairman's land eighty five  
perches to a corner white oak thence South 13 degrees easterly three hundred thirty eight  
perches to a ditch at the said River then down the said River West twenty five perches  
and a half to the place of Beginning Containing Ninety five acres.
