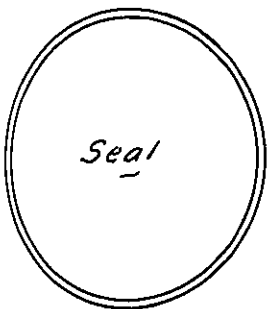

At the Request of Rebecca Shippen That we would grant her a Resurvey on twelve hundred Acres of Land belonging to the Estate of her former Husband Francis Richardson Situate in Wrightstown in the County of Bucks eleven hundred forty and four Acres thereof adjoining on Newtown Line & the Lands now or late of Joseph Ambler and John Chapman and the remaining fifty six acres <sup>lying</sup> in common in the Townstead of Wrightstown <sup>afors<sup>d</sup></sup>; These are to Authorize and Require thee to Resurvey <sup>or cause to be resurveyed</sup> to the said Rebecca Shippen the said twelve hundred Acres of Land according to its true Bounds and first Lines of Survey and make Returns thereof into the General Surveyors Office at Philad<sup>ia</sup> where this Warrt is to remain and a copy thereof to be transmitted to thee, certified by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicate of this Return into his Office. Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> y<sup>e</sup> 18<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> 1701.
