Pennsylvania, & ye Territories thereunto belonging

At ye Request of Jn^o Town, late Purchaser y^t I would grant
him to take up a Spott of Land in ye County of Bucks on Nashameni
Creek joyning to Nicholas Waln's Line, contening about Two hundred
acres. These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be
survey'd unto him ye s^d vacant Land, provided it be not already taken
up, according to ye method of Townships appointed by me, & make returns
thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia, y^e 21st of y^e 12th
1683.
