I hereby authorize thee to survey & set out unto him ye said quantity if not already taken up, according to ye new method of Township^s appoynted by ye Govr^mt And make return thereof w^{ch} is to remaine on Record in my office Philadelphia ye 22nd 12th m^o 1683
