At ye request of Jacob Telner^{late} purchaser of five thousand acres,
yt we would grant him to take up one thousand acres of Land, in part
thereof in the County of Bucks and on Neshamenesh Creek if possible.
These are therefore in the Proprietary's name to will & require thee forthwth
to survey or cause to be surveyed unto him the said number of acres, in the
afore s^d County, where not already taken up, according to the method of
Townships appointed by the Govern^r, he seating & improveing the same wth in
six moneths from the date of survey and make Returns thereof into the
Govern^r's Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia the 2^d of ye 4th mo 1685
