



By virtue of a Warrant from the Commission^{rs} of Property bearing date the 6th day of the 6th month 1716 Surveyed unto Shadrach Wally William ^{Buckman} John Frost Stephen Twining William Croasdale James Yates John Wally William Buckman Jun^r Thomas Mayberry & Aaron Pearson (joynt Purchasers) a certaine strip of Land lying in the townstead of Newtown in the County of Bucks on a branch of Neshaemenah Creek; Begining at a black oak at the s^d Stephen Twining's Corner ffrom thence running north thirteen degrees easterly two hundred thirty four perches by the s^d Stephen Twining William Buckman John Johnson & Ezra Croasdale's Lotts. to a Post at the s^d John Frost's Corner, Then by the s^d Frost's Line South sixty three degrees east twenty two perches & an half perch to a Post on the east side of the s^d ranch, Then by the s^d John Frost Shadrach Wally & James Yates Lotts South by West two hundred twenty eight perches to a stump of a tree, Then west by North by the s^d Yates's Line twenty five perches & an half perch to the place of bequing (allowing for Roads laid out by the first survey) Containing in quantity thirty three acres three Rods & twenty eight perches Surveyed the 20th day of the 6th month 1716.
