



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietary's Commiss<sup>rs</sup> to me directed bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the 10<sup>th</sup> month 1701. Surveyed and laid out unto Paul Woolf a Tract of Land in Soulberry Township in Bucks County beginning at a Post by a Road, being Hartley's Corner, Thence by the said Hartley's line N.E. 320 per. to a Post, Then N.W. by vacant 150 per. to a Post in an Indian field, Then S.W. by Jedediah Allen's Land 320 per. to a Post by the said Road, Then by the same S.E. 150 per. to the place of beginning, Containing 300 acres Surveyed and Laid out the 29<sup>th</sup> day of the 3<sup>d</sup> month 1702.
