



Resurveyed the 7th day of the 12th month 1701 by virtue of a Warrant from the Governour dated the 10th of the 11th month 1700 unto William Waite one hundred and three Acres, one half, and thirty two perches in Southampton in the County of Bucks Beginning at a Corner marked Post in Thomas Harding's line Thence by the same N.E. 68 perches to a Corner marked White oak, Then N.W. by Samuel Allen's land 244 ^{perches} to a Corner marked White oak, Then S.W. by Joseph Paul's land 68 perches to a Corner marked White oak, Then S.E. by Jackman's land 244 perches to the place of Beginning.
