


Pensilvania ss.



By the Commissioners of Property

At the Request of William Wilkinson of the County of Bucks That  
we would grant him to take up the Quantity of one hundred acres of Land  
the Remainder untaken up of one Thousand acres the original purchase  
made of the late Proprietary by John Alsop by Deeds dated the 21 & 22 dayes of  
the Month called March Anno Domini 1681 ye Right of which said one hundred  
acres by several Conveyances being now vested in the said William -  
Wilkinson. These are to Authorize & Require thee to survey or cause to be  
survey'd in the aforesaid Right according to the Method of Townships ap-  
pointed the said Quantity of one hundred acres of Land that has not been already  
Survey'd nor appropriated nor is seated by the Indians and make Returns thereof into  
the Secretary's Office in order for a further Confirmation. Given under our hands  
and the lesser seal of the Province at Philadelphia the first day of September  
Anno Domini 1725
