These are to authorize and Require thee to survey or cause to be Surveyd unto the said Shadrach Wally William Buckman and John Frost and so many of the Inhabitan<sup>ts</sup> of the said Township as shall within one month after the Date hereof come in and pay their several shares or Proportions of the Purchase ~~money~~ and other charges arising on the same The said Strip of Land Reputed to contain about thirty acres and to Divide off to every Person holding land in the said Townsted so much of the said Strip as fronts his Land Respectively all which is to Lye and Continue for the Publick use and behoof <sup>of</sup> the said Shadrach Wally William Buckman John Frost and others of the said Township that will associate themselves as aforesaid and make a Return thereof into the Secretary's office which survey in case the above mentioned Persons or some of them fulfil the above agreement within one month after the Date hereof shall be valid otherwise the same is to be void as if it had never been <sup>made</sup> nor this Warrant ever granted Given under our hands and ~~the~~ seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 6<sup>th</sup> day of the 6<sup>th</sup> month Anno Domini 1716.
