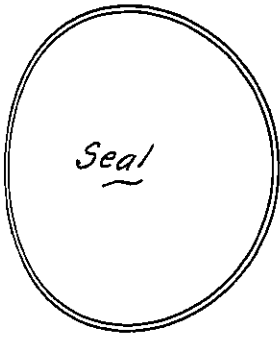

 We would grant him a Resurvey on a certain Tract of Land Situate on
 Neshamint Creek in Bucks County now in the possession of ~~the~~ Ralph
 Draycott laid out for and reputed to contain two hundred and fifty acres
 Originally taken up in right of the 5^d Nicholas's first Purchase by the Widow
 Walmsly. These are to authorize and require thee exactly to resurvey the said
 Tract of Land and ~~in~~ in case it fall short of the quantity it should contain
 then to make up the Deficiency out of any of the adjacent Tracts from which so
 much may be spared and return the same so made up into the general Surveyors
 Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered
 to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Prov-
 ince at Philad^{ia} the 24th of the second month 1704.
