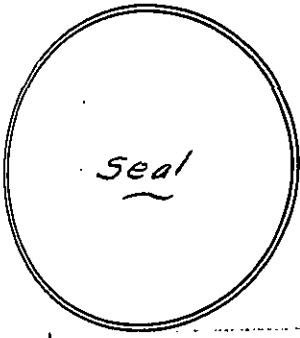


Pennsylvania 55

By the Commission^{rs} of Property

At the Request of Peter Weshart of Philad^{ia} That we would Grant him Three hundred Acres of Land in y^e Tract called the great Swamp in the County of Bucks adjoining on the ^{head} ~~furthest~~ most Line of the Surveys already made there, for which he hath agreed to pay to y^e Proprietors use forty Pounds for the whole within three months. These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be survey'd to the said Peter Weshart according to y^e Method of Townships appointed the said quantity of three hundred Acres or more if he think fitt to take it on the same terms with the other in the place aforesaid in one regular Tract, and make a Return thereof into y^e Secretaries Office in order to a further Confirmation. With which Agreement if the said Peter shall duly comply the said Survey shall be valid otherwise the same shall be void and of no Effect as if it had never been made nor this Warr^t ever granted.
