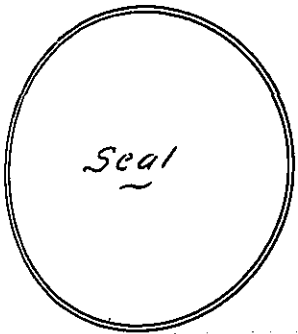

At the Request of Shadrach Walley of Newtown in the County of Bucks That we would grant him a Resurvey on several Tracts of Land lying contiguous and in his possession in the s^d County viz on one Tract laid out for 250 acres being his original purchase, one Tract laid out for the s^d quantity to Benja: Roberts, & one Tract reputed 223 acres purchased of Israel Taylor between two of which Tracts there also lies a parcel of Land reputed 200 acres claimed formerly by Will^m: Sneed: These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey according to ye true Bounds and first Lines of Survey the first three aforementioned Tracts comprehending also the s^d parcel of 200 acres. And make returns of the whole and of ye s^d 200 acres particularly & separate into the Surveyor Generals Office where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the Secretary.
