William Penn Proprietary & Govern<sup>r</sup> of ye Province of  
Pennsylvania & ye Territories thereunto belonging

At ye Request of Henry Waddy Purchaser of Seven hundred  
and fifty Acres of Land, y<sup>t</sup> I would grant him to take up ye remainder  
of his Purchase (being one hundred eighty eight Acres ~~& one tract~~) in  
ye County of Bucks. These are to will & require thee to survey ye s<sup>d</sup> Land  
unto him about ye second month of ye next year, ~~where~~ in ye County  
afores<sup>d</sup> where not already taken up, according to ye method of Townships  
appointed by me, he seating & improving ye same w<sup>th</sup> in six Months after  
ye Date of ye Survey, & make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office.
