

Pursuant to a warrant under the hands of the Commissioners of Property and the seal of the Province bearing date the 11th day of the sixth month 1702 Granting unto George Willard of the County of Bucks a Resurvey on two severel parcels of land in the said County the one laid out for two hundred and forty six acres to Joseph Paul in Right of Edward Blenman the other granted for one hundred acres to Thomas Rowland.

There is Resurveyd to George Willard a tract of land near Southampton in the County of Bucks beginning at a marked white oak at the corner of William Waits land from thence by the land of Hort Gregory Morris Hart and Rush north west seven hundred ninety eight perches to a corner black oak sapling from thence by John Parsons land northeast sixty eight perches to black oak in Jn^o Burden's line from thence by the said line and by other land south east seven hundred and fifty perches to a corner post thence north east 232 perches to a white oak from thence by Sam^l. Allen's land south twelve degrees and a half east 278 perches from thence North west by Will^m Waite's land 102 perch^s.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twenty-fourth day of May 1909
