Pursuant to a Warrant under the hands of the Commissioners of Property and the seal of the Province dated the 11th of ye 7th 1702 Granting unto George Willard of the County of Bucks a Resurvey on two Several parcels of land in ye said County the one laid out forty six acres to Joseph Paul in Right of Edward Blenman the other granted for one hundred acres to Thomas Rowland both in the said George's Possession.

Resurveyd unto George Willard a Tract of land nere Southampton in the County of Bucks beginning at a white oak marked at the Corner of William Waites land from thence by - Hort - Gregory - Morris - Hart & - Rushes land north west six hundred and twenty six perches to a Post thence north east by the Proprietaries land sixty eight perches to a Post Then by Dungen Rowles and Jn^o Shaw's land south east five hundred seventy eight perches to post from thence north east 232 perches to a white oak, Then by Samuel Allen's land South 21 deg^s and a half westerly 278 perches to a spanish oak marked P.C. then by William Waites land north west 102 perches to white oak Then south west 68 perches to the Beginning Containing three hundred seventy four acres. Resurveyd the 20th day of the 6 month by Jn^o Cutler
