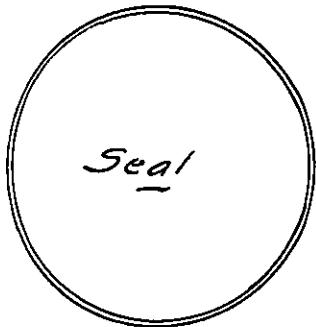


Pensylvania ss

At the Request of Henry Comley of the County of Bucks That we would grant him a Resurvey on a certain Tract of Land laid out to his father in ye Township of Warminster in the said County in right of his Original Purchase of Five Hundred Acres which to compleat the said Purchase ought (as is alledged) to contain three Hundred Acres: These are to Authorize & Require thee forthwith to Resurvey or cause to be Resurvey'd to the said Henry Comley in the place aforesd the said quantity of Three Hundred Acres in order to compleat the said Purchase (should so much be found due to him) And make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 15th day of the first month 17th 1792
