Whereas Thomas Chalkley of the City of Philad^{ia} in the 5^d Province
 Sawyer hath produced unto us Deeds Poll of Lease & Release und^r the Prop^{ty}
 hand & seal bearing date the third & fourth days of April Anno Din 1695 Pur-
 porting a Grant & Release by the 5^d Prop^{ty} unto William Townsend of South-
 wark in the County of Surrey his heirs & assigns of three hundred acres of
 Land in this Province between the Rivers Susquehannah & Delaware And also
 other like Deeds bearing date the nineteenth & twentieth days of June Anno
 Din 1710 Purporting a Grant & Release of ye 5^d 300 acres of Land ~~unto~~ by the
 5^d William Townsend unto the 5^d Thomas Chalkley his heirs & Assigns And the 5^d
 Thomas Chalkley requesting of us a Warrant for the Location of the P^rmisses
 These therefore are to authorize & require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd
 unto the 5^d Thomas Chalkley according to the method of Townships appointed the full
 quantity of three hundred acres of Land in this Province between the Rivers afores^d That has
 not been already survey'd, nor taken up, nor is seated by the Indians and make returns
 thereof into the Secretaries Office. Given under our hands & Seal of the Province the
 eighth & twentieth day of the seventh month (at Philad^{ia}) in the year of our Lord 1710
