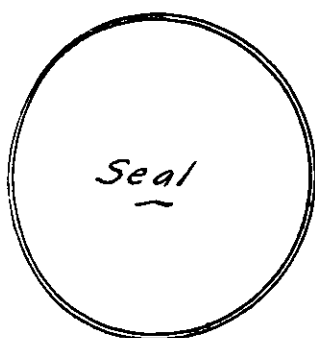


Pennsylvania SS

At the Request of Thomas Chalkley that we would Grant him a Resurvey on a certain Tract of Land Scituate in Warminster first laid out for five hundred acres to John Jones of London since Decd who purchased the same of ye Propriet^{ys} and the said John Dying without Issue his only Sister ^{& heir} Elizabeth Hilton by Deeds of Lease & Release dated ye 3^d 4th dayes of September 1719 Granted & Conveyed the same unto the said Thomas Chalkley. These are to authorize and Require thee to resurvey or cause to be resurveyd ~~unto the said Thomas Chalkley~~ the said Tract of Land according to ye first lines & bounds thereof and cut off ye over plus together with eight acres the proportion of Liberty Land at ye Southeast end of ye said Tract and make exact Returns of the same into the Secretarys Office in order for a further confirmation Given under our hands & ye lesser seal of the Province at Philadelphia the fifth day of ye Second Month Anno Din 1720
