



By virtue of a Warrt fr^d the Proprietaries Commiss^rs to me directed bearing d^d the 10th day of the 1st month 17⁰⁰ Surveyed and Laid out unto Thomas Carus A Tract of Land in Souberry Township in Bucks County begining at a Post by a black oak being A Corner of Sedidiah Allen's Land, Thence by the said Allen's Line N.E. 320 perches to a Post near a spanish oak on one side and a white oak on the other side marked T.C, Then by vacant Land N.W. 225 per to a Post by a great maple in a Run, Then by Blackshaw's Line S.W. 320 per to a Post by a Road, Then by the said Road S.E. 225 per to the place of beginning Containing 450 acres Surveyed and laid out the 29th day of the 3^d month 1702
