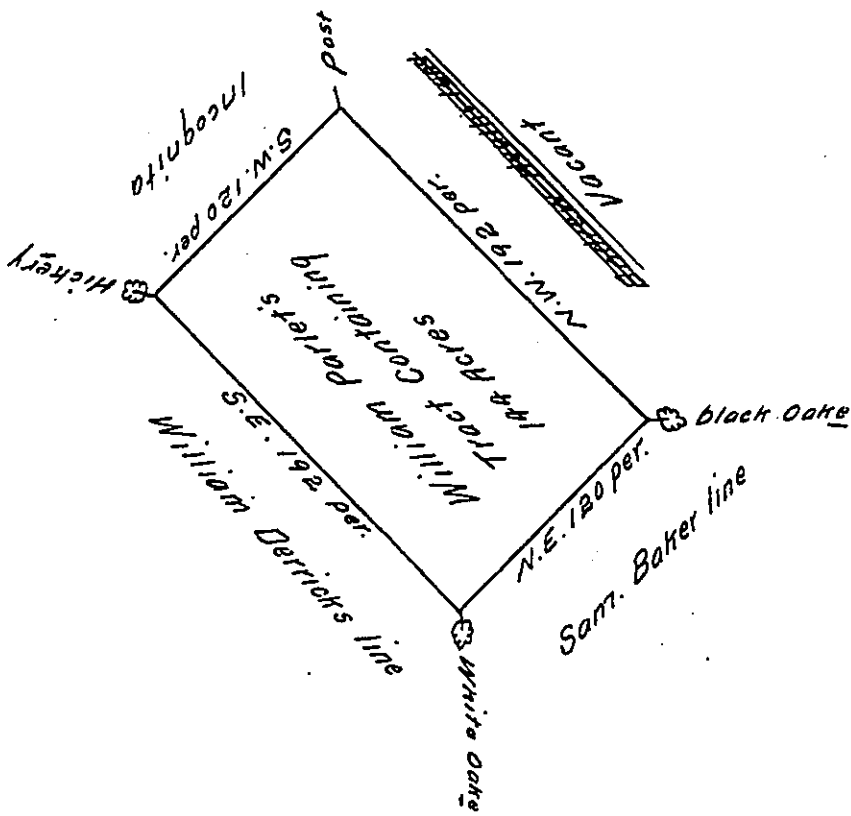

Resurveyed the 14th day of the 11th month 1701 by virtue of
 an order from the Governour dated the 17th of the 8th month 1701 unto
 William Parlet one hundred and forty four Acres neare Rights Town
 in the County of Bucks beginning at a corner marked White Oake
 in Samuel Bakers Line, Thence by the same North East 120 perches
 to a corner marked black Oake, Then North West by Andrew Heaths Land
 192 perches to a corner post, Then South West one hundred and twenty
 perches to a corner marked Hickery, Then South East by William Derricks
 Land one hundred and ninety two perches to the place of beginning
 Certified under my hand.
