



Resurveyed the 17th day of the 12th month 1701 by virtue of a Warrant from the Governour dated the 31st day of the 3^o month 1701, unto John Pidcock five hundred and five Acres within the Governours Mannor of Highlands in the County of Bucks beginning at a Corner marked Chestnut tree by the River Delaware being Gilbert Wheelers Corner, Thence up the said River N. 40 deg. W 212 perches to a Corner marked black oak, Then West 330 perches to a Corner marked small Black Oak, Then South 230 perches to a Corner marked Hickery, Then E. 9 deg. N. by the said Wheelers land 473 perches to the place of beginning, given under my hand.
