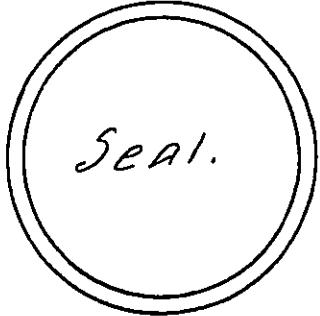


Pensilvania s. s.

Deficient Tract the said quantity of fifty three Acres & thereby make up the Deficiency aforesd. And make Returns thereof forthwith into the Secretaries Office. Given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia}. the 3^d. day of December 1707.
